

How We Name The Notes

Music is written on a staff made up of five lines. Notes are written on these lines or in the spaces between them. They can also be written in the spaces below and above these lines.

Notes are given names based on the letters of the alphabet from A through G.

Each staff begins with a **clef**. Music for different instruments is written in different clefs. The recorder you are playing uses the **treble** clef. Here are the names of the notes of the staff in treble clef:



It may help you to remember the notes on the lines by remembering the sentence Every Good Boy Does Fine. The notes in the spaces spell out the word FACE.

How We Count Music

Below are some of the notes we use in massic. Each note has a name and a value or length. Here are their American names and values in 4/4 time.

quarter note	4	(13)	1 bear
eighth note	D	(6)	1/2 beat
eighth note pair	л	(ci-ci)	I beat
dotted quarter note	2	(nee)	1 1/2 beats
half note	0	(two-cos)	2 beats
dotted half note	d	(three-oe-ee)	3 beats
whole note	0	((0-0-0-01)	4 beats

A rest is a silence. For every note, there is a rest of equal value. Here are some rem we will use in our music

quarter rest	1	(sh)	1 beat

Munic is written to that we read it from left to right and top to bottom, just as we read a book. Our music is divided into accisons called **measures** or **bars**. Measures are separated by **bar lines**. A **double bar line** is placed at the end of a song.




