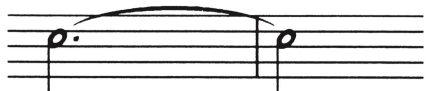

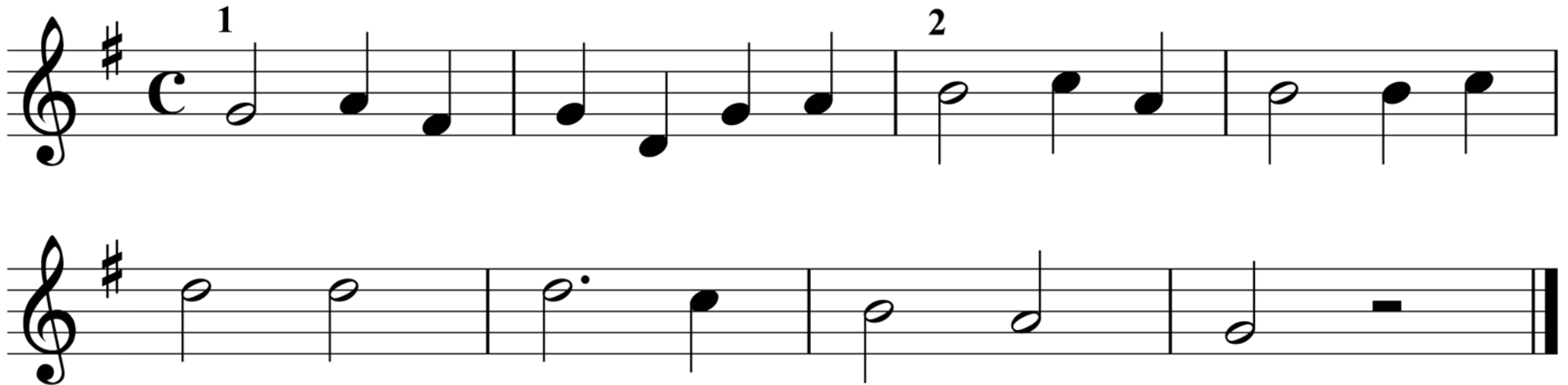
The dots under or on top of a note indicate that it should be played staccato.

**Staccato** - To play staccato you must play very short, leaving space between the notes. You should not speed up, just leave a space before you start the next note. The beat remains steady.

**Canon or a Round** - To pass level two you must play this piece with a partner as a round. One player starts and when he gets to the number two, the second player starts playing from the beginning. End after playing the piece 3 times.
